“What’s going on this week at WideSpot?” is a question asked throughout the region. Folks ask the question not because they’re confused, but because WideSpot provides such a broad range of entertainment options that a visitor might find a Grammy winning musical act, or a community gathering with a pot luck, or a play, or maybe a film.

WideSpot is a community based, non-profit performing arts center located in Stockholm just above the Pie Shop. It seats 125 people, maximum, and has a stage, full sound system, lighting, a bar, and a following of fans from around the region. You’ll find the schedule is laid out by season, so you can plan your schedule accordingly.

For people interested in music listening, the artists who perform here uniformly talk about how nice it is to play for an audience that listens. We’ve had blues, jazz, classical, bluegrass, Irish, Finnish, Swedish, Country, Cajun, French, Dixieland, rock, folk, Americana and other styles on stage over the years.

Theater goers can enjoy performances by the WideSpot players, or area youth who attend our theater camp, or participate in a murder mystery interactive show to find out who really done it.

In years past, WideSpot has hosted four or five Gumbo Kickoffs, where the top three chefs win fabulous prizes. We’ve hosted pot luck meals to benefit our neighbors and community organizations. We’ve had guest speakers talking about water quality issues, sand mining concerns, and park planning concerns.

We’ve been fortunate enough to partner with the Flyway Film Festival for many years, providing a large screen, as well as technical expertise to show films each October.

You’ll find WideSpot has events from late August through early June. There are enough fun alternatives in the region during the summer months that we take some time off.

The tiny space on the corner of the Great River Road and Spring Street in "downtown" Stockholm

was charming and very "friendly"... all 500 square feet of it... and that included the counter, the dining area seating about 12, the kitchen and the bathroom :) From the beginning, lines were out the door. Soon they added on delicious lunches and expanded the space to seat about 60, along with a charming general store filled with nostalgia, candy, and fun! And lines are still to the doors in the busy season. Then in 2018, they added the Pie Plate Cafe and Red Wing General Store in Red Wing, MN. The shops are destinations for pie and food lovers around the globe. It all started around the kitchen table of one of the owners - a brother/sister/brother-in-law

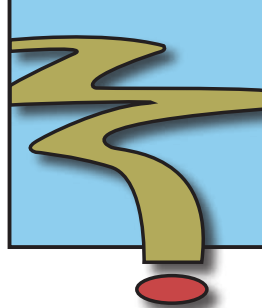
combination. They took a bite of the apple dumpling that she had made and they jokingly said "hey, we could sell these, they are so good!" What set it apart from any other pie was the crust,... that flaky, crazy delicious crust. To this day, every pie is made from scratch with that crust, one at a time. You won't find any cans of filling or commercially made things... just real fruit, sugar, spices and that secret recipe crust... and don't forget the whipped cream... also a treasured secret. The menu has grown to include a broad array of sandwiches, those famous pot pies

Shindig Marvel is conveniently located at Humble Moon Folkstead, on Hwy 35 in Stockholm, no more than 20 minutes from 9 of the local venues. It's an easy pick up location, unless you've opted for delivery and maybe even set-up. Better yet...you don't have to wash any dishes! Sarah will wash all of the dishes when they are returned, which is included in the reasonable rental rates.

Sarah began this business several years ago while working as an event coordinator at a large venue. She witnessed all of the waste generated during events, from floral centerpieces to plastic cake plates and cocktail cups, all of it heaped into the dumpster after its heartbreaking one-time use. Already having a love of old things and a weakness for vintage linens, a new idea was born. Now, unwanted china and mismatched goblets have found a home and get to attend party after party, as conversation pieces while party guests reminisce over 'Grandma's china pattern' and past happy occasions.

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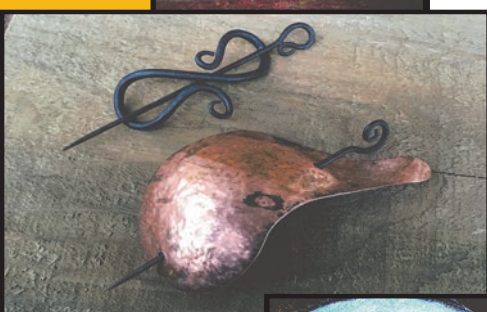

As you stand near the crosswalk at the 4-way intersection of Hwy 35 and Spring Street in Stockholm, look up river and you'll see a little corner pub, painted in lime green and proudly displaying the nostalgic Texaco sign. This quaint landmark is currently known as **Bryoni's Pub & Eatery**.

Here you'll find a casual menu and cozy, laid back atmosphere. It's the kind of place where a few of the regulars have 'the usual'

for lunch. It's the kind of place where the neighborhood kids pop in for a root beer, because it tastes better out of a glass bottle. It's the kind of place where strangers engage with each other while striking up a conversation with the table next to them. It's the kind of place where the staff will treat you like a friend and upon another visit or two you'll likely be treated as family.

Feel free to grab a game to play at your table while you wait for your food. On a nice day you can sit on the deck under an umbrella and watch the parade of travelers passing by on the highway. If you have a canine companion along you are welcome to dine with them at a picnic table in the backyard. If you happened to ride your horse to town, tie your horse up at the neighbor's hitching post. You can enjoy your food and drinks at **Bryoni's** while keeping an eye on your steed.

Speaking of the neighbors, that's their place with the tall, peaked building full of mismatched windows. You can take the footpath off of **Bryoni's** deck, across her backyard, and under 'The Kissing Arch' (go ahead and kiss whoever is walking with you). This multi-structure property is known as **Humble Moon Folkstead**. If



you've wandered over while waiting for your food, no worries, they'll holler off the deck for you when your burger is up (just like at home). You may find lively chickens eagerly running to greet you, looking for a quick pat on the back or a hand full of corn.

The tall building hosts a rustic style shop and art gallery named **Antique Future**, featuring works made in North America by talented artists and craftsmen, including work by owners Dan & Sarah. They'll share with you the stories of the artists so that you can connect with a deeper appreciation. You may find Dan at his wood fired forge, hand-forging metal while you watch.

Also housed in the tall building is **Shindig Marvel Vintage Event Rentals**. Sarah collects mismatched china, glassware, vintage linens, decor and more that she rents out for waste-free celebrations taking place at the nearby venues.

The little house on the property is known by the community as the 'Pink House'. It is currently under renovation to be home to old fashioned lodging rooms as well as space for art classes, workshops or other small gatherings. The front porch is often open for story time and for guest artists to showcase their work.

The **Folkstead** hosts markets in the front yard, offers hitching posts to horse riders, sells holiday Christmas Trees, and keeps community donated crafts supplies on-hand for kids to make projects free of charge.

These two neighboring properties have found strength in working together. They like to keep things friendly by joining their yards. Some of their collaborations include a May Day Celebration which involves live musicians, a May Pole, fire dancers, and a craft table where you can make May Baskets. One of Bryoni's cooks even happens to be a talented Henna artist. Families mingle back and forth and can hang out until after dark with a campfire.

Another exciting collaboration is during October to celebrate Halloween. You'll find both yards decked out, with a spooky tour which starts on the porch, goes through the Pink House Freak House, and ends in Bryoni's back yard.

It's a destination to be enjoyed by young and old.

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MAIDEN ROCK

Where Legend & Beauty Come Alive on the Shores of Lake Pepin

Maiden Rock is a small village nestled in the foothills and bluffs of the Mississippi River. It is named after an Indian legend of a Dakota maiden who leaped from the bluff top to avoid a forced marriage. The village was founded in the early 1850s and called Harrisburg. The name was changed to Maiden Rock in 1857.

Maiden Rock is a popular destination for travelers of the Mississippi Flyway. The area is a bird-lover's paradise hosting diverse habitat for bald eagles, sand hill cranes, trumpeter swans and tundra swans, white pelicans and countless species of waterfowl. The Flyway is a special place during migratory season with avian travelers passing through.

Maiden Rock is also home to musicians, visual artists and notably artful shops including Cultural Cloth, Swan Vision Gallery, The Green Queen, Limbo Records & Rarities, Secret Heart Gallery and the Smiling Pelican Bakeshop. Other amenities include the superbly renovated schoolhouse of the Maiden Rock Inn, ongoing music presentations at the Six String Saloon, steady refreshment at Ole's Bar & Grill, outdoor dining at Vino in The Valley and yoga classes at Santosha Center.

For an extraordinary experience in nature, Maiden Rock is a stone's throw away from many stunning landscapes, including Rush River Produce's legendary blueberry farm, breathtaking acreage and lodging at Journey Inn and Pepin Farm Pottery, apples and beverages at Maiden Rock Winery & Cidery, the outdoor concert series at Liberty Tree Farm, the Rush River Delta, Pine Creek (a trout fisherman's favorite) and easy to access trails across the prairie restoration at Maiden Rock Bluff.

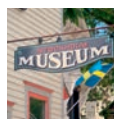
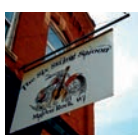

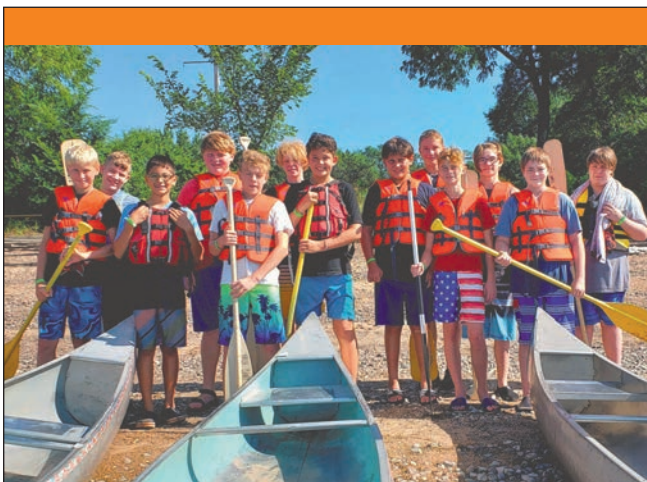
